Bestwood edging

Bestwood has its own range of matched edging for every colour in the Bestwood Melamine range. Thinner is better when it comes to edge tape and we offer an expanded range of 1mm edging plus laser edgetape for selected colours.

Substrates

Melamine paper can be pressed on a variety of substrates and the choice is generally determined by the end use. A large wall panel will likely have a different substrate than what is required for a desk, wardrobe, or kitchen drawer.

Our current substrate availability chart is available to view or download from the technical resources page of the Bestwood website.



MDF

This substrate is the most commonly used as it's suitable for most applications. A heavier weight than particleboard and low formaldehyde with an EO rating. Also available in MDF MR (moisture-resistant).



PARTICLEBOARD (PBD)

This is a very cost-effective substrate with good strength and density. Available in standard and moisture-resistant (MR) versions when it is destined for highmoisture environments.

Fire rated wall and ceiling panels

Different areas within buildings require different Group Numbers based on use and occupancy, risk group and building importance level. Group Numbers are a numeric representation of the reaction-to-fire of a surface finish using a scale rating. They represent how quickly a fire will spread across the surface.

- Bestwood melamine, when pressed on MDF FR Black achieves a Group 1s.
- Bestwood melamine on MDF FR MR achieves a Group 2s.

Fire certificates can be provided on application to support project-specific compliance.

With 1800 wide panels

For commercial projects such as office desking or for wall panels, our 1800-wide panel may be a more economic option than our standard 2440 x 1220mm size.

Bestwood offers seven colours in a wider 2440 x 1830 panel or 1830 x 1830 panel. These can be pressed on four different thicknesses – 12mm, 16mm, 18mm and 20mm. Note that Arctic White is designed primarily for the interior of drawers and shelves, and priced accordingly. It does not form part of our colour melamine offer.



Standard 2440 x 1220 panels are available across the entire Bestwood Melamine range. All our New Zealand-made MDF panels are rated EO for formaldehyde and come in a range of thicknesses. Our particleboard is rated E1. To check panel sizes and thicknesses, just visit the Technical Resources page of the Bestwood website.

Environmental considerations



At Bestwood we try our very hardest to leave as gentle a footprint as possible. It's easy to say but harder to do. We are genuine in our efforts to improve our environmental performance.

We continue to search for alternative products that meet the growing needs of our environmentally-conscious customers while creating processes in our manufacturing that are mindful of the environment for future generations.

Our key initiatives include:

- Having Eco Choice Aotearoa accreditation for our melamine panels pressed on MDF or particleboard. This means they contribute valuable points for Greenstar and Homestar projects.
- Supplying low-formaldehyde board E0 for our standard, moistureresistant and fire-retardant MDFs, and E1 for particleboard.
- Reducing manufacturing waste and also finding new ways to re-use and recycle any that is generated.
- Finding new ways to reduce energy consumption and only using electricity from 100% certified renewable resources for our manufacturing sites.

Our purpose-built plant in East Tamaki (with Greenstar *4 accreditation) features a number of initiatives that have significantly improved our environmental footprint.

Care instructions

Bestwood Melamine is easy to care for and daily cleaning requires no more than a wipe with a damp cloth and hot soapy water. For tougher stains we recommend trying:

- We also recommend caution in using bleach and alcohol-based cleaners. Dilute bleach (1 part bleach, 3 parts water).
- Citrus-based cleaners can cause a sticky build-up on the surface if not thoroughly wiped

• After using the solutions recommended, always wipe with a damp cloth, then a dry cloth.

• Never use abrasive cleaners or abrasive cleaning cloths, such as wire wool scourer pads,

Bestwood Melamine is made here in New Zealand with back-up for any issues close at hand. It's a very durable surface and we offer a 10 year warranty – subject to normal use conditions. To view a full copy of the warranty, please download from our website at www.bestwood.co.nz.

LIMITATIONS OF USE

Bestwood Melamine is designed for interior use only and should not be used in areas where it will be exposed to high moisture levels i.e. as an exterior wall lining, or wet areas in regular contact with water. It is not suitable for benchtops in kitchens and bathrooms.
